

**Eligibility:** Entry to this tournament is limited to the first 14 NCAA sanctioned women's bowling teams. Spots will be awarded on a first come, first serve basis. The tournament will be certified by USBC Collegiate.

**Cost**: The entry fee is \$220.00 per team. The entry fee must accompany the entry form by October 15, 2007. The entry fee is based upon (\$165.00 for bowling and \$55.00 for awards and expenses).

**Format**: This tournament uses a scratch scoring system. Five player teams will compete in a three day competition that will consist of 14 NCAA matches (7 traditional games + 7 quadruple Baker matches). Total pinfall of the 14 matches will determine the final tournament place. In the event of a tie for any place, the school that had the highest pinfall in the matches involving only the schools that were tied will take the higher position.

Lane assignments will be determined by luck of the draw using a standard league schedule. Every attempt will be made to ensure that no two schools face each other multiple times under the same match format.

Awards: Awards will be given to the championship team and the runner up team. Individual awards will consist of tournament most valuable player and five all All-tournament team awards. All tournament team will be given to the top five averages with a minimum of 5 games bowled. MVP will be selected by the head coaches and is not solely based on the player's average. Each school will also be awarded with a team MVP trophy to be given to each participating school's most valuable player. There is no minimum game requirement to receive the team MVP award.

**Team Rosters**: There is a limit of ten players per team. Official rosters must be submitted prior to the beginning of the tournament. All participants must keep bags and extra bowling balls in the paddock area. Substitutions may be made at any time, but a player removed cannot re-enter until the next game begins.

**Rules Compliance**: USBC general playing rules and NCAA rules will be observed. All disputes will be handled by the tournament director and (if needed) by the head coaches of all of the participating teams. The tournament director has the authority to adopt a rule for any situation that is not covered in the rules.

Other Notes: Team practices will not be permitted on the day of the event at the facility of the competition. Teams must adhere to the dress code as described in the NCAA handbook. One lane courtesy will be observed. Each team must designate a coach or team captain, who will be responsible for the conduct of their team at all times.

**Facility Information:** 

Rock River Lanes is located 15 minutes from the University of Wisconsin – Whitewater campus. The facility features 16 Brunswick Lanes, with AMF Automatic Scoring. The facility features a pro-shop, a lounge, a snack bar, and numerous updates including meeting room spaces and a miniature golf course. The lane surface is Brunswick Pro Lane, and the installation occurred in May, 2007.

Rock River Lanes intends to offer a practice session to all participating teams during the afternoon of Thursday, November 8<sup>th</sup>. The practice session will be available for a nominal charge. During the practice session, the lanes will be dressed with the name pattern as will be used during the Cheeseland Classic.
